At the last union meeting...we, the local union leadership, expressed our position regarding the proposed UAW-Ford National Tentative Agreement. That position was and still remains the same.

We are in support of this agreement due to the fact that it provides security for our members, their families and the community. In addition, there was also a resounding support by the over 200 plus members in attendance.

The ratification of this National Agreement has become very controversial at a handful of facilities that have already voted.


As a point of information, we have been notified by the UAW National Ford Department to prepare for a strike in the event that this Tentative Agreement is not ratified.


Our local union is now in the process of doing the following:

- Preparing picket signs
- Developing a strike picket roster.
- Selecting Strike Captains
- Once selected for picket duty, food bank...etc, you will be required to report in order to receive Strike Fund Assistance.
- The Strike Fund Assistance currently stands at **\$200 a week-per member, plus healthcare.**


We ask that this membership carefully consider the decision that stands before...**all of us,**
